The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the following labeling changes before ship product:

1. On the Front Panel after your product name revise the text as follows:

An Avicide for Repacking or Formulating into Registered Baits for Control of Starlings and Blackbirds around Livestock and Poultry Operations.

Starlicide is a slow acting avicide.

2. Revise your "Statement of Practical Treatment" as follows:

Statement of Practical Treatment

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

3. Revise your "DANGER" statement as follows:

DANGER

Fatal if absorbed through the skin or inhaled. Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage. May be fatal if swallowed.

Wear protective clothing and rubber gloves. Wear goggles, face shield, or safety glasses. Wear a dust/mist filtering respirator (MSHA/NIOSH approval number prefix TC-21C).

Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

- 4. In your "Container Disposal" section, change "application" to "repacking or formulation" since you could not legally use this product in "application" equipment.
- 5. Revise your "Environmental Hazards" section as follows:

This product is toxic to birds and freshwater invertebrates. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
