# How to Use Starlicide Complete

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

The application of Starlicide Complete should be made at the proper time and place under the direction of personnel trained in bird damage control. Normally, the starling's diet consists of insects and fruits; but in winter months when food is in short supply, they're attracted to feedlot areas. Best results are obtained where starlings have few alternate foods. Careful observations of starling habits should be made to establish preferred feeding sites and to determine that no protected bird species are present that may feed on the bait. Prebaiting may be necessary for successful use of the agent.

This product is not effective against English or house sparrows.

#### For Livestock Feedlots

Place in feeding stations or scatter Starlicide Complete thinly and uniformly over dry or frozen areas of empty pens, alleyways, and other areas inaccessible to livestock. Application should be made before starlings arrive for their first morning meal. One baiting may last up to three days.

The quantity of Starlicide Complete required should not exceed twenty pounds per acre for large lots (over ten acres) nor exceed fifty pounds per acre for small lots (under ten acres).

## Fo. Poultry Operations

Place in feeding stations or scatter Starlicide Complete thinly and uniformly over dry or frozen areas on the outside of pens, buildings, or range areas. Application should be made before starlings acrive for their first morning meal. One baiting may last up to three days. Because Starlicide Complete is toxic to chickens, turkeys or other poultry, it should not come in contact with these species.

The quantity of Starlicide Complete required should not exceed twenty pounds per acre for large lots (over ten acres) nor exceed fifty pounds per acre for small lots (under ten acres).

NOTE: Do not expect to find large numbers of dead starlings and/or blackbirds in the baited area as most die within one to three days after consuming the treated pellets. Most die at their roost and along flight lines to the feeding areas. If starlings or blackbirds continue to be a problem, reassess the problem and consider prebaiting. Do not rebait within three days of initial application as some birds consuming a lethal dose of PURINA Starlicide Complete may require three days to be affected.
