CORROSIVE. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Harmful if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles, face shield or safety glasses. If Swallowed: Call a doctor or get medical attention. Do not induce vomiting. Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or if there are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid Alcohol.

Note To Physician: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression, and convulsion may be needed.

USE DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Odor Control is designed for the temporary relief of odors. This product will mask unpleasant odors and effectively reduce many organisms which cause odors.

1. For sanitization of farm livestock and poultry area:

Remove all poultry and animals from premises. Remove all feeds from premises, cars, boats, trucks, and other equipment. Remove all litter and manure from floors, walls, and surfaces of barns, pens, stalls, chutes, and other facilities or fixtures occupied or traversed by poultry or livestock. Empty all troughs, racks, and other feeding and watering appliances. Mix **Odor Control** at the rate of one ounce per gallon of water. Saturate floors or walls with this solution by spraying or sprinkling. Immerse all halters, ropes, and other types of equipment used in handling or restraining animals as well as forks, shovels, or scrapers. Ventilate buildings, coops, cars, boats, and other closed spaces. Do not house poultry or livestock or employ equipment until treatment has been absorbed, set, or dried. All treated feed racks, mangers, troughs, automatic feeders, fountains and waterers must be thoroughly rinsed with potable water prior to re-use.

USE DIRECTIONS(Continued)

- 2. **For deodorizing pet animal quarters, zoo area, or kennels:**
Spray or sprinkle solution of 1 ounce **Odor Control** per gallon of water in problem areas. More concentrated solutions may be needed depending on the intensity of the odor.
- 3. **Odor Control** may also be used to mask unpleasant odors, pet animal quarters, or kennels in the following manner: Mix 1 ounce of **Odor Control** with 1 quart of water and place in an open pan in an enclosed area. Add plain water to the pan daily until it is no longer effective at which time new solutions should be made up.

NOTE: Do not use with soap or other cleaners.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store in original container at temperatures above 32° F. Store in an area inaccessible to children and animals.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

Container Disposal: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
