The Agency has reviewed your company's December 15, 1995 application for an amendment (OPP Identifier No. 180701) to the registration for the above product. Your submission contains an application for an amendment for a product name change, a change in use pattern, a new CSF, and forwards copies of a proposed label. Your submission was a follow-up to your September 26, 1995 meeting with the Agency's Special Review Branch and an October 5, 1995 Agency letter requesting the formal submission of an application for an amendment to the registration for a product name change.

The amendments referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, are acceptable with the following provisions:

- (1) You must submit a letter canceling all other formulas for the product. The Confidential Statement of Formula for "Fly Patrol (Fly Bait)" dated December 15, 1995 needs the inclusion of the supplier name & address for the Bitrex (Denatonium benzoate) ingredient. This revised CSF will the become the sole, valid CSF.
- (2) The use directions must be changed to separate scatter bait use directions from bait station use directions. Scatter bait is not permissible in/around dog kennels and stables but bait stations are.
- (3) For bait stations use directions, include the statement that "Bait stations must be located at least four feet from the ground. "
- (4) Pursuant to the Office of Pesticide Programs Policy regarding existing stocks, the Agency establishes the following provisions for existing stocks of methomyl fly baits of yellow, or any other unacceptable color:

- Sale of yellow (or any other unacceptable color) fly baits by registrants will be allowed until September 31, 1996.
- Sale of yellow (or any other unacceptable color) fly bait by anyone other than the registrants will be allowed only until December 31, 1997.

Caged Poultry and Turkey on Wire: Scatter FLY PATROL (Fly Bait) on walkways at the rate of 1/2 lb per 500 sq. ft. to aid in controlling house flies. Also scatter outdoors around doorways.

Dog Kennels and Furbearing Animals Units: Scatter FLY PATROL (Fly Bait) around outside areas to dog pens, runways, and other surfaces out of reach of the animals. For cage units, scatter on walkways at the rate of 1/2 lb per 500 sq. ft.
