

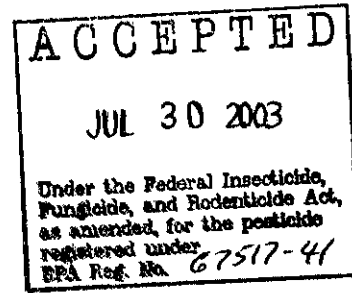

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS**

This product is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposing of equipment washwaters.

Shrimp and crabs may be killed at application rates recommended on this label. Do not apply where these are important resources.

**DIRECTION FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard.

**To Operate: Shake Before Using:** Remove shipping cap and save. Insert sprayer hose into bottle and tighten securely. Prime sprayer by holding cap level on bottle while pumping trigger. Turn nozzle to "spray" or "stream" position before using. Hold pump sprayer 18 to 24 inches from foliage or leaf surfaces being treated. Direct spray so that upper and lower surfaces are contacted. Use caution on new growth and tender foliage. Remove sprayer and replace shipping cap between uses. Spray water through sprayer after each use. Sprayer should be rinsed thoroughly and pumped empty for storage.

This insecticide may be used outdoors or in greenhouses throughout the growing season.

To control insects named, apply this spray to provide thorough coverage of upper and lower leaf surfaces.

**For Use On The Following Ornamentals:** African Violets, Asters, Azaleas, Begonias, Camellias, Carnations, Chrysanthemums, Dahlias, Dogwood, Geraniums, Gladiolis, Marigolds, Roses, and Wandering Jew.

**To Control:** Aphids, Flea Beetles, Leafhoppers and Whiteflies.

**To Kill:** Gypsy Moth Caterpillars and adults, adult Japanese Beetles and Eastern and Forest Tent Caterpillars on contact.

**On Trees and Shrubs:** Treat trees and shrubs as soon as insects emerge (usually late spring). Treat leaves, branches and tree trunks evenly, making sure to penetrate dense foliage. Repeat applications every 7 days as necessary for control.

**On Roses and in Flower Gardens:** Treat plants and flowers as soon as insects appear. Spray plants and flowers making sure to penetrate dense foliage. Repeat application every 7 days or as necessary for control.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE (CONTINUED)**

**INDOORS AS A SPACE SPRAYER**

**To Control:** House Flies, Fruit Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats and Small Flying Moths: Apply using a good space sprayer adjusted to deliver a fine mist. Cover or remove exposed food and food handling surfaces. Close windows and doors and shut off ventilating systems. Direct spray toward upper portions of the enclosure filling the room with mist. Use 4 to 5 ounces per 1000 cubic feet of space. Keep area closed for at least 30 minutes. Vacate treated areas and ventilate before reoccupying. Repeat treatment as necessary.

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**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

**PESTICIDE STORAGE:** Do not transport or store below 32°F. If frozen, thaw and shake well. Store in original container in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** If **Empty:** Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If **Partly filled:** Call your local solid waste agency 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place any unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
