Beginning at the head, pour along the center of the back.  
Apply 1/2 fluid ounces per 100 pounds body weight of animal  
up to a maximum of 5 fluid ounces for any one animal.

Repeat treatment as needed, but not more than once every 2 weeks. For optimum lice control a double treatment at 14-day intervals is recommended.

Special Note: HARD HITTER Cattle Pour-On Insecticide is not effective in controlling cattle grubs.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

**Pesticide Storage:** Keep container sealed when not in use. Do not store near food or feed.
