NOTE: This product is not being reregistered under sections 3(c)5 and 4(g) of FIFRA at this time.

Please be reminded that 40 CFR Part 156.140(a)(4) requires that a batch code, lot number, or other code identifying the batch of the pesticide distributed and sold be placed on non-refillable containers. The code may appear either on the label or durably marked on the container itself, and can be added by non-notification per PRN 98-10.

Restrictions for use in commercial animal premise automatic misting systems. Not for use in outdoor residential misting systems (indoor or outdoor).

Do not apply this product in barns or stables where animals intended for slaughter or human consumption will be maintained.

Do not apply when food, feed, or water is present.

When using this product, installers and service technicians must comply with the license, certification, or registration requirements of the state(s), tribes(s), or local authority(ies) where they are installed.

Do not apply this pesticide when people, pets, and/or food are present.

When applying via a remote activation device, do not apply when people and pets are present. If possible, when applying via automatic timer, set the timing for application when people and pets are unlikely to be present.

Direct nozzles to spray towards the target area and away from areas where people are typically present.

Ready To Use: Pour along back. Apply 1/4 fl. oz. (7.5cc) per 50 lbs body weight of animal, up to a maximum of 3 fl. oz. for any one animal. Repeat treatment as needed, but not more often than once every two weeks. For optimum lice control, two treatments at 14-day intervals is recommended.

Ready To Use: For use as a spot spray or premise spray, in a mist sprayer. Apply directly to surface to leave a residual insecticidal coating, paying particular attention to areas where insects crawl or alight. One gallon will treat approximately 7,300 square feet. Repeat treatment as needed but not more often than every two weeks.
