 - c. Under Directions for Use change "Federal Law" to "Federal law".
 - d. Under Directions for Use delete "For space spraying/fogging indoors, wear a NIOSH or MSHA approved respiratory device.".

- e. On the front panel add "Agricultural/Commercial use Only".
- f. On page 4 move "use only on dogs" under the paragraph for dogs.

Remove birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

For space spraying/fogging indoors, wear a NIOSH or MSHA approved respiratory device.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING.

In animal quarters and milk rooms: For rapid control of House Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Wasps, Hornets, Bees and Small Flying Moths, close windows and doors and spray at the rate of 2 seconds per 1000 cubic feet of space. For best results, keep area closed for 10 minutes after spraying. Do not remain in treated area and ventilate after treatment is completed.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE (Continued)

LIVESTOCK:

Beef Cattle, Dairy Cattle, Goats, Sheep, Hogs And Horses: To protect from attacks of Stable Flies, Horse Flies, Deer Flies, Face Flies, House Flies, Horn Flies, Mosquitoes, and Gnats, spray about 3 seconds on each side being careful to spray back, withers and forelegs thoroughly. To protect from face flies, spray the face and head, but do not spray into eyes. Repeat treatment when flies are troublesome.

Swine: Do not ship animals for slaughter within 5 days of last treatment.

Blood Sucking Lice: Apply to the infested areas of the animal using a stiff brush to get the spray to the base of the hair. Repeat every 3 weeks if required.

Poultry Lice: Spray roosts, walls and nests of cages thoroughly. This should be followed by spraying over the birds with a fine mist.

Cockroaches, Waterbugs, Palmetto Bugs, Silverfish, Firebrats, Crickets, Scorpions, Spiders, Millipedes, Centipedes, Sowbugs, and Pillbugs: Spray into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, behind sinks, cabinets, along baseboards and floors, around drains and plumbing, hitting insects with spray whenever possible. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Ants: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

DOG PREMISES:

Fleas and Ticks (Adult and Larvae): Remove and thoroughly clean or destroy pet bedding. Spray pet sleeping quarters, bed, entire floor and floor covering with special attention to cracks and crevices around baseboards, and window and door frames. Infested upholstered furniture may also be treated with this product. A test application should be made to upholstery or drapery fabrics in an inconspicuous place before use. Use only on Dogs.

DOGS:

Fleas, Ticks and Lice on Dogs: Using protective gloves (or mitts), start at the tail, stroke against the lay of the hair, spraying the parted fur in short bursts, directly behind the hand to insure penetrating the coat. Dampen the fur up to the head, repeat application weekly if necessary to control infestations.

NOTE: Do not use on dogs under 12 weeks of age.

WAREHOUSE AND GRAIN STORAGE AREAS:

Indian Meal Moths, Angoumois Grain Moths: Close doors and windows, direct spray into all parts of room especially around stored food product containers, pallets and darkened areas. Spray 7 to 10 seconds for each 1000 cubic feet of space. Keep area closed for 15 minutes following treatment. Repeat application as necessary.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE (Continued)

Exposed stages of Confused Flour Beetles, Saw-Toothed Grain Beetles, Red Flour Beetles, Rice Weevils, Granary Weevils, Grain Mites: Spray into cracks and crevices, processing and handling equipment, around cartons or containers or other areas where these insects tend to congregate. Spray 30 seconds for each 100 square feet of surface. Keep area closed for 45 minutes to 1 hour after treatment. Repeat application as necessary. Infested stored food products in the home should be disposed of.

Carpet Beetles: Spray directly on beetles, floors, baseboards, shelves and carpets. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Bedbugs: Spray mattresses, particularly around tufts and seams. Take beds apart and spray into all joints. Treat baseboards, moldings and floors. Repeat treatment as necessary. Allow mattresses and other articles to dry thoroughly before use.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Pesticide Storage: Store in a cool dry area. Do not transport or store below 32° F.

Pesticide Disposal: Securely wrap original container in several layers of news paper and discard in trash.

Container Disposal: Replace cap and discard containers in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
