

FIRST AID

If Inhaled

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

READ ENTIRE LABEL BEFORE EACH USE:

Do not use in food areas food handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas where food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where food may be prepared or held. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed.

Nonfood areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling).

Remove protective cap, hold container upright and spray from a distance of 12 to 15 inches.

Remove birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE.

In animal quarters and milk rooms: For rapid control of House Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Wasps, Hornets, Bees and Small Flying Moths, close windows and doors and spray at the rate of 2 seconds per 1000 cubic feet of space. For best results, keep area closed for 10 minutes after spraying. Do not remain in treated area and ventilate after treatment is completed.

LIVESTOCK:

Beef Cattle, Dairy Cattle, Goats, Sheep, Hogs and Horses: To protect from attacks of Stable Flies, Horse Flies, Deer Flies, Face Flies, House Flies, Horn Flies, Mosquitoes, and Gnats, spray about 3 seconds on each side being careful to spray back, withers and forelegs thoroughly. To protect from Face Flies, spray the face and head, but do not spray into eyes. Repeat treatment when flies are troublesome.

Swine: Do not ship animals for slaughter within 5 days of last treatment.

Blood Sucking Lice: Apply to the infested area of the animal using a stiff brush to get the spray to the base of the hair. Repeat every 3 weeks if required.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE (Continued)

Poultry Lice: Spray roosts, walls and nests of cages thoroughly. This should be followed by spraying over the birds with a fine mist.

Cockroaches, Waterbugs, Palmetto Bugs, Silverfish, Firebrats, Crickets, Scorpions, Spiders, Millipedes, Centipedes, Sowbugs and Pillbugs: Spray into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, behind sinks, cabinets, along baseboards and floors, around drains and plumbing, hitting insects with spray whenever possible. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Ants: Spray trails, nests, and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat treatment as necessary.

<u>DOG PREMISES</u>: Fleas and Ticks (Adult and Larvae): Remove and thoroughly clean or destroy pet bedding. Spray pet sleeping quarters, bed, entire floor and floor covering with special attention to cracks and crevices around baseboards, and windows and door frames. Infested upholstered furniture may also be treated with this product. A test application should be made to upholstery or drapery fabrics in an inconspicuous place before use.

<u>DOGS:</u> Fleas and Ticks and Lice on Dogs: Using protective gloves (or mitts), start at the tail, stroke against the lay of the hair, spraying the parted fur in short bursts, directly behind the hand to insure penetrating the coat. Dampen the fur up to the head, repeat application weekly if necessary to control infestations. Use only on Dogs. Do not use on dogs under 12 weeks of age.

WAREHOUSE AND GRAIN STORAGE AREAS:

Indian Meal Moths, Augoumois Grain Moths: Close door and windows, direct spray into all parts of room especially around stored food product containers, pallets, and darkened areas. Spray 7 to 10 seconds for each 1000 cubic feet of space. Keep area closed for 15 minutes following treatment. Repeat applications as necessary.

Exposed stages of Confused Flour Beetles, Saw-Toothed Grain Beetles, Red Flour Beetles, Rice Weevils, Grain Mites: Spray into cracks and crevices, processing and handling equipment, around cartons or containers or other areas where these insects tend to congregate. Spray 30 seconds for each 100 square feet of surface. Keep area closed for 45 minutes to 1 hour after treatment. Repeat application as necessary. Infested stored food products in the home should be disposed of.

Carpet Beetles: Spray directly on beetles, floors, baseboards, shelves and carpets. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Bedbugs: Spray mattresses, particularly around tufts and seams. Take beds apart and spray into all joints. Treat baseboards, moldings and floors. Repeat treatment as necessary. Allow mattresses and other articles to dry thoroughly before use.
