SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE

AS A DIP FOR DOGS AND CATS:

Dilute at the rate of 3 ounces in 1 gallon of water. For rapid control of ticks, lice and fleas sponge, or dip solution on entire animal, thoroughly wetting the skin. Avoid contact with pet's face eyes. Do not reapply more often than once every 7 days. **AS A MI**

For rapid control of ticks, flea and lice with a mist sprayer. Dilute at the rate of 1 ounce in 9 ounces of water. Spray ticks directly. Apply to moisten the fur lightly. Repeat as needed, but do not apply more often than once each day.

AS A PREMISE/YARD SPRAY: To Control Insects in Kennels and Animal Quarters.

Dilute at the rate of 1 ounce in 10 ounces of water.

Remove pets before treating the area and ventilate thoroughly before allowing them to re-enter the treated area.

For rapid clean-out of fleas and ticks in kennels, apply with a good machine adjusted to deliver coarse droplets. Apply to the point of runoff, with special attention to cracks and crevices and other insect hiding places. Bedding should be removed and sprayed thoroughly. Repeat as needed, but do not apply more often than once each day.
