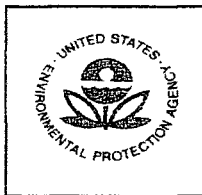

On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act. Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

Based on your response to the Rodenticide Cluster Reregistration Eligibility Decision, EPA has reregistered the product listed above. This action is taken under the authority of section 4(g)(2)(C) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended. Reregistration under this section does not eliminate the need for continual reassessment of pesticides. EPA may require submission of data at any time to maintain the registration of your product.

Generic data requirements that have been identified in the RED as confirmatory data for the active ingredient contained in the subject product will continue to be tracked and assessed in the Agency's continual reassessment of pesticides.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable provided that you submit one (1) copy of your final printed labeling, with the changes below, before you release the product for shipment:

- 1. On Page 2, after "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" revise the text to read:

May be fatal if swallowed. Harmful if absorbed through skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and after handling. Wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet.

- 2. EPA does not have jurisdiction to require Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) for manufacturing-use products. However, we have no objection if you wish to retain your current PPE in the last sentence of your April 2, 2002 version of your label:

In the case ... or inhalation.

- 3. Place your "First Aid" text with the rest of your "**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS**" after your text under "**WARNING**".
- 4. Because the acute inhalation test was Toxicity Category 4, rather than Toxicity Category 2, you may delete the "If Inhaled" text under "First Aid", at your option.
- 5. After your "First Aid" text, add a "**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN OR VETERINARIAN**" :

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN OR VETERINARIAN

This product is not an anticoagulant rodenticide. If ingested, limit absorption by either emesis or gastric lavage. Sublethal symptoms, if present, would be the result of cerebral edema and should be treated accordingly through administration of an osmotic diuretic and corticosteroid.

- 6. Revise your use directions as follows:

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Only for formulation into a rodenticide for

- i. the following uses: in and around buildings, inside transport vehicles, in sewers (Norway rat, roof rat, and house mouse);
- ii. uses for which USEPA has accepted the required data and/or citation of data that the formulator has submitted in support of registration; and
- iii. Experimental Use Permits that are in compliance with the requirements of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.

Formulators using this product are responsible for obtaining EPA registration for their formulated product.

7. Follow Enclosure 2, "Minimum Type Sizes for Final Printed Label". Also, "Skull and Crossbones" and "POISON" must in red text.

8. Under "**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**", revise "**Container Disposal**" to "**Container Handling**" followed by instructions for each type of container. In general, you will be adding the new text required by the "Container Regulations" (40 CFR 156.140 – .159) and explained in PRN 2007-4 to the existing container disposal instructions. Contact us if you need assistance in developing correct text. Also, all products distributed or sold in nonrefillable containers will need batch codes on the label or the container.

The acceptable Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) for this product is dated October 27, 1998. All other versions are obsolete.

Stocks of product with existing labels may be used for eighteen (18) months.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

3. uses for Experimental Use Permits that are in compliance with the requirements of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.

FIRST AID

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- If Inhaled
