The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided you submit one (1) revised final printed label with the following changes before releasing the product for shipment:

1. Add "A Rodenticide for Formulating Other Registered Products for the Following Sites: [list]" to the front panel directly below the product name.
2. Add "Only for formulation into a rodenticide for the following uses(s) [Fill blank only with those uses that are being supported by MP registrant]." to the Directions for Use.
3. Within the **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**, revise the paragraph to read "*Uses to control Norway Rats, Roof Rats, and House Mice and in and within 50 feet of homes, industrial and agricultural buildings, related port or terminal buildings, and similar man-made structures. This product may also be used within 50 feet of surrounding buildings in alleys and inside transport vehicles (ships, trains, aircraft).*"
4. Revise **CONTAINER DISPOSAL** to read **CONTAINER HANDLING**.

Once the changes noted above are instituted, this product will be in full compliance with the Agency's revised May 28, 2008 "*Risk Mitigation Decision for Ten Rodenticides*". Should you wish to add a reference to the company's website on your label, please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act.



2. Uses for which the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has accepted the required data and/or citations of data that the formulator has submitted in support of registration; and
3. Uses for Experimental Use Permits that are in compliance with the requirements of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.

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## SIDE/BACK PANEL

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### FIRST AID

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- If Swallowed**
