Dear Mr. Dyer,

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Your application for amended registration for EPA Reg. No. 67517-65, dated January 14, 1997, and the proposed revised labeling submitted with your application have been reviewed. Your application and revised label are acceptable provided you 1) submit or cite efficacy data for this product, as discussed below, and 2) modify your label as indicated below.

 According to our records, the only Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) ever accepted for this product was the CSF dated "2/24/83". The only formulation that may be used for this product is the one described by that CSF.

Our records do not show a clear listing of efficacy data supporting the registration of this product as described by the CSF dated 2/24/83. You must submit or cite efficacy data which indicate that this product can be used to make effective rodenticide baits. For any efficacy data cited, you must be able to document that this product's current accepted formulation (CSF dated 2/24/83) was used in the preparation of the bait(s) that were tested. If the data are "owned" by another entity and eligible for data compensation, we will need written authorization from that entity to permit us to consider their relevant data.

- 2. Please make the following changes to your proposed label:
  - a. Replace the "NOTE TO FORMULATORS:" with a "DIRECTIONS FOR USE" section. This new section should read as indicated immediately below.



## **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product may be used only to formulate enduse rodenticide baits which are to be used for any or all of the following purposes:

- uses to control Norway rats, roof rats, and house mice in and around homes, industrial and agricultural buildings, similar man-made structures, inside transport vehicles (ships, trains, aircraft), in and around related port or terminal buildings, and in alleys located in urban areas;
- 2. uses for which the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has accepted the required data and/or citations of data that the formulator has submitted in support of registration; and
- 3. uses for Experimental Use Permits that are in compliance with the requirements of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.

The exact content of the first-listed item in these use directions might have to be adjusted to be consistent with the labels of such products, if any, which contain the 67517-65 concentrate and are supported by accepted efficacy data.

b. On the center panel of the label, replace

# FOR FORMULATION ONLY INTO REGISTERED RODENTICIDES

with

# FOR FORMULATION ONLY INTO END-USE RODENTICIDE BAITS AS DESCRIBED IN THE DIRECTIONS FOR USE WHICH APPEAR ON THE SIDE/BACK PANEL.

c. Replace the "ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS" statement with the statement specified by PR Notice 93-10 for manufacturing use

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products as follows:

## "ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or other waters unless in accordance with a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA."

d. In the fifth sentence under "**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS**" change "breath" to "breathe."

When revising your label, retain the organizational format proposed in your submission of January 14, 1997. Note that the heading for the "DIRECTIONS FOR USE" section should be centered as it must be parallel to the other major headings (e.g., "PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS", "ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS," "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL", etc.).

Please submit or cite the requested efficacy data and one copy of your revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. If the above specified conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
