Dear Mr. Dyer,

Your submission of proposed revised labeling for EPA Reg. No. 67517-73, dated April 10, 1998, which included revised labels for a 7-lb. "IMMEDIATE CONTAINER" and for a 4 x 7-lb. "OUTER PACKAGE," has been reviewed. The revised labeling is acceptable provided that you:

- 1. On the front panel of both labels, insert the word "feeding" between "single" and "with" in the modified single-feeding claim.
- 2. Retain the organizational format for the "DIRECTIONS FOR USE" that was used in the proposed labels submitted April 10, 1998.

Please submit one copy each of your revised final printed labeling for the "IMMEDIATE CONTAINER" and the "OUTER PACKAGE" before you release the product for shipment. 

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

IMPORTANT: Do not expose children pets or other nontarget animals to rodenticides. To help to prevent accidents:

1. Store product not in use in a location out of reach of children and petso.

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DIRECTIONS FOR USE (CONTINUED)

- 2. Apply bait in locations out of the reach of children, pets, domestic animals and nontarget wildlife, or in tamper-resistant bait stations. These stations must be resistant to destruction by dogs and by children under six years of age, and must be used in a manner that prevents such children from reaching into bait compartments and obtaining bait. If bait can be shaken from stations when they are lifted, units must be secured or otherwise immobilized. Even stronger bait stations are needed in areas open to hoofed livestock, raccoons, bears, or other potentially destructive animals, or in areas prone to vandalism.
- 3. Dispose of product container and unused, spoiled and unconsumed bait as specified on this label.

USE RESTRICTIONS: For control of Norway Rats and Roof Rats in and around homes, industrial and agricultural buildings, and similar man-made structures. This product may also be used in alleys located in urban areas, inside transport vehicles (ships, trains, aircraft), and in and around related port or terminal buildings. Do not use ASSAULT RAT PELLETS in Sewers. Do not place bait in areas where there is a possibility of contaminating food or surfaces that come in contact with food. Do not broadcast bait.

SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS: Determine areas where rodents will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these are along walls, by gnawed openings, in or beside burrows, in corners and concealed places, between floors and walls, or in locations where rodents or their signs have been observed. Protect bait from rain or snow. Remove as much alternative food accessible to rodents as possible.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS: ASSAULT RAT PELLETS do not contain an anticoagulant rodenticide. Generally, rats will consume a lethal dose in a single feeding with death occurring one or two days later.

Apply 1 to 6 oz per placement. Adjust the amount applied to the level of rat feeding expected at each bait placement. Placements should be spaced at 20 to 30 foot intervals.

Highest bait consumption is expected to occur during the first day or two after treatment. After several days, inspect bait placements and replenish bait at sites where there is evidence of heavy feeding. Although one night's feeding will usually provide a lethal dose, maintain bait for at least a week to provide all rodents a chance to feed on the bait. Baiting should be continued until all sign of feeding have ceased.

Collect and properly dispose of all dead rodents and leftover bait. To discourage reinfestation, limit sources of rodent food, water, and harborage as much as possible. If reinfestation does occur, repeat treatment. Where a continuous source of infestation is present, establish permanent bait stations and replenish as needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store in original container in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets. Keep containers closed and away from other chemicals.
