NOTE TO PHYSICIAN or VETERINARIAN

Contains the nerve poison bromethalin. This product is not an anticoagulant type rodenticide. For humans or animals ingesting bait and/or showing poisoning signs (such as muscle tremors, loss of hind limb use, or seizures for animals), limit absorption by either emesis or gastric lavage. Sublethal symptoms, if present, would be the result of cerebral edema and should be treated accordingly through administration of an osmotic diuretic and corticosteroid.

This product is extremely toxic to mammals and birds. Dogs and scavenging mammals and birds might be poisoned if they feed upon animals that have eaten this bait.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

IMPORTANT: Do not expose children, pets or other nontarget animals to rodenticides.

To help prevent accidents:

1. Store product not in use in a location out of reach of children and pets.

2. Dispose of product container and unused, spoiled and unconsumed bait as specified on this label.

USE RESTRICTIONS: This product may only be used to control House Mice inside of homes and residential buildings. This bait station may be used in indoor areas accessible to children, consistent with all use restrictions and other requirements indicated in this label. DO NOT USE THIS PRODUCT OUTDOORS OR IN AREAS ACCESSIBLE TO PETS. Do not place this ready-to-use bait station in any area where there is a possibility of contaminating food or surfaces that come into contact with food. Do not place near or inside ventilation duct openings. Do not break station and/or deliberately remove bait from it.

SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS: Determine areas where house mice will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these are along walls, by gnawed openings, in corners and concealed places, between floors and walls, or in locations where house mice or their signs have been seen. Remove as much alternative food as possible.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS: The active ingredient in this product is different from anticoagulant rodenticides. Individual house mice cease feeding after consuming a toxic dose.

House Mice: Place a single unit at each placement location. Space placements at 8 to 12 foot intervals. Replace units if contents are consumed or contaminated, or if units are severely damaged. If units are untouched after three days, move to new locations consistent with label text. Continue baiting until all signs of house mouse activity have ceased.

FOLLOW UP: Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately. Using waterproof gloves, collect and dispose of all dead, exposed animals and leftover bait properly. To prevent reinfestation, limit sources of food, water, and harborage for house mice as much as possible. If reinfestation does occur, repeat treatment.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store only in original container in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets. Keep containers closed and away from other chemicals.
