EPA Registration Number 67546-1
Submission Dated September 9, 1996

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below:

1. Revise the Precautionary Statements to read as follows:

"Harmful if swallowed. Causes eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling."

2. Under the Environmental Hazards Statement, remove the following sentences:

"Boric acid or boric acid solutions . . . when disposing of equipment washwaters."

A stamped copy of the label as well as a copy of the Agency's efficacy review are enclosed. Submit three copies of revised final printed labeling prior to releasing product for shipment.
