Purpose The purpose of your resubmission is to amend the label of your product in accordance with our letter of July 29, 2002

Review of label The labeling submitted with the above letter, under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) is acceptable, provided you submit one (1) copy of final printed labeling to us, with the following changes, before you ship your product. A copy of the stamped label is enclosed for your records.

1. Revise your homeowner "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL" text as follows:

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Keep in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets.
Keep container tightly closed to prevent evaporation. Store above 32 F. If frozen, completely thaw and stir well before using.

Disposal:

- **Empty containers:** Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling, if available.
- **Partly filled containers:** Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Do not place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.

Existing stocks of labels Stocks of existing labels may be used for eighteen (18) months.

Consequence for non-compliance If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of this condition.

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

Use Restrictions

Do not use in commercial food processing or preparation areas. In the home, cover all exposed food, food processing surfaces and utensils during treatment. Do not spray food or feed crops.

For both indoor and outdoor situations use training whenever possible, including positive (praise) and negative (sharply spoken word backed up with disciplinary action) reinforcement. This product repels dogs and cats for up to 24 hours when applied daily. Keeps pets away from furniture, carpet, trees, shrubs, garbage cans/bags and other "forbidden areas."

Indoor Use

Use indoors to break your pet of undesirable habits such as sleeping on furniture and rugs or to keep out of forbidden areas. Always use with consistent training. Praise your pet for good behavior and scold for bad behavior.

Pretreatment Directions: Before spraying large areas of rugs, fabrics or plastics, test the effect of this product by treating a small, inconspicuous area. This product may stain or soften some fabrics or plastics. To avoid possible damage, lightly spray a piece of cloth and place it on the object or area to be protected.

Application Directions: Lightly spray the object to be protected with this product until slightly moistened.

Retreatment Directions: Repeat daily, or as necessary, until undesirable habit is broken.

Outdoor Use

Use outdoors to prevent dogs and cats from disturbing flowerbeds, lawn areas, trees, shrubbery, fences, patio furniture and garbage cans/bags.

Note: This product is not likely to break the established urination patterns of dogs unless it is used as a training aid.

Pretreatment Directions: Stray animals are frequently attracted to areas that pets have soiled with feces or urine. To discourage repeat visits, remove any droppings and clean area with water.

Application Directions: Do not apply directly to foliage of shrubs or to ornamental, soft-bodied plants. Do not apply to food or feed crops. Lightly spray surrounding soil or apply to a piece of cloth and affix near area to be protected.

Retreatment Directions: Repeat daily, or as necessary, until undesirable habit is broken.
