DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Storage and Disposal

Storage: Store in a cool, dry (preferably locked) place inaccessible to children and pets. Protect from freezing. **Disposal:** Do not use empty container; wrap and put in trash.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

DOGS AND CATS

Hold bottle in upright position when spraying cats and dogs: Cover animal's eyes with hand and with a firm stroke to get a proper spray mist, spray head, ears and chest until damp. With fingertips, rub into face around mouth, nose and eyes. Then spray neck, middle and hind quarters, finishing legs last. For best penetration of spray to the skin, direct spray against the natural lay of the hair. On long haired dogs, rub your hand against the lay of the hair, spraying the ruffled hair directly behind the hand. Make sure spray thoroughly wets ticks. Do not reapply product for one week. Do not use on puppies or kittens under 12 weeks. Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, medicated, aged, pregnant or nursing animals.

For Use As A Wipe

Cover pet's eyes with hand. Wipe head, ears and chest until damp. Rub into face around mouth, nose and eyes, avoiding direct contact with the eyes. For best penetration to the skin, direct wipe against the normal lay of the hair. Make sure wipe thoroughly wets ticks. Do not reapply product for one week. Do not use on puppies or kittens under 12 weeks. Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, medicated, aged, pregnant or nursing animals.

Pet Sleeping Quarters

Spray around baseboards, windows, door frames, wall cracks and local area of floors. If mosquitoes, gnats or flies are present, lightly spray into the air. Repeat as needed. Spray pet's bedding and the area beneath the bedding. After the spray has dried, remove old bedding and replace with fresh bedding. Treat pets with a flea and tick control product registered for use on pets before allowing them to enter treated area.

HORSES AND FOALS

Use full strength to control stable flies, horse flies, deer flies and face flies. Apply to face, legs, flanks, top line and other body areas commonly attacked by these flies. Do not wet horse's skin with excessive spray. After application, thoroughly brush to bring out bright sheen on coat. If treatment of foals under six weeks old is necessary, spray fingertips and rub onto coat. Repeat treatment as needed. Not for use on horses/foals intended for human consumption.

For Use As A Wipe

First, brush animal to remove excess dirt and dust. Rub wipe into face around mouth, nose, eyes, ears and areas where flies are often seen. Then wipe the neck, legs, shoulders and shanks. Do not wet horse's skin with excessive spray. After application, thoroughly brush to bring out bright sheen on the coat. Repeat treatment as needed. If treatment of foals under six weeks old is necessary, spray on fingertips and rub onto coat.
