Your application The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Two (2) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

- 1) Please reinstate related compounds plus percentage for permethrin in the ingredient statement. These related compounds still appear on the labeling for your source products and it's active/inert status has not been determined.
- 2) Reinstate the asterisk and cis/trans ratio for permethrin since the toxicity of this chemical varies by ratio.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Storage and Disposal

Storage: Store in a cool, dry (preferably locked) place inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat and open flame. Store above 32°F and protect from freezing. Disposal: Do not reuse empty container; wrap and put in trash.

HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT. SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING.

Kills Fleas up to 14 days on dogs and cats. Kills Ticks on dogs up to 4 days and up to 9 days on cats.

Spray the animal from a distance of 8-12 inches. Start spraying at the tail, moving the dispenser rapidly and making sure the animal's entire body is covered, including the legs and underbody. Fluff the hair as you spray so the spray will penetrate to the skin. Thoroughly wet ticks. Do not spray in animal's face, eyes or on genitalia. Do not reapply for one week. Do not use on puppies or kittens under 12 weeks. Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, medicated, aged, pregnant or nursing animals.
