The Agency in accordance with the Federal Fungicide and Rodenticide Act as Amended (FIFRA) has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the aforementioned product in connection the MGK 326 RED, and have concluded that your submission is acceptable.

The Agency is in the process of developing and improving the current Efficacy Assessment Guidelines for repellent products. The Agency intends to defer the determination of any related efficacy data requirements supporting the claims that may appear on this label until these Efficacy Assessment Guidelines are complete. When the guidelines are finalized, the Agency expects to issue a Data Call-In to address the revised guidelines to all registrants with registrations for personal repellent products that have not previously submitted efficacy data sufficiently consistent with the revised guidelines.

NOTE: This product is not being re-registered under FIFRA Sec. 4(g) at this time.

RegWest Company, LLC on behalf of Contract Packaging, Inc. should note that a notice of availability of EPA's reregistration eligibility decision (RED) documents for products containing:

- Pyrethrins was published in the Federal Register on July 26, 2006 (Volume 71, Number 143, Pages 42387-42389).
- Piperonyl butoxide was published in the Federal Register on July 26, 2006 (Volume 71, Number 143, Pages 42385-42386).
- MGK 264 was published in the Federal Register July 26, 2006 (Volume 71, Number 143) Page 42381-42383).

As a result of these REDs, additional data and/or labeling changes may be required for products containing pyrethrins and/or piperonyl butoxide, and MGK 264.



DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Do not use on horses or foals intended for slaughter.

Dogs • Puppies • Cats • Kittens

Do not apply over cuts, wounds or irritated skin. Do not apply near eyes and mouth. Apply sparingly around ears. Treatment may be applied on a bandage. Do not use on puppies or kittens under 12 weeks. Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, medicated, aged, pregnant or nursing animals.

To Kill and Repel Ear Mites: Clean ear to remove built-up wax and dirt. Gently dry ear with a cotton ball or soft cloth and apply a thin film of treatment. The treatment may be applied daily for 7 to 10 days. To Kill Ticks: Make sure treatment covers ticks.

To Use as a Repellent: Spread treatment lightly on outer and inner surface of the outer ear and between the toes before animals enter infested area. Do not repeat treatment for 3 to 5 days.

Horses • Foals

To Control Ticks, Gnats, Flies, Mosquitoes and Mange Mites: Before application remove dirt or debris by brushing or washing with a mild shampoo. Allow to completely dry. Apply a light film to affected areas daily, massaging into the skin for 2 to 3 days, then apply every 3 to 5 days as needed. Do not apply over cuts, wounds or irritated skin. Do not apply near eyes and mouth. Apply sparingly around ears.

Storage and Disposal

Pesticide Storage: Store in a cool, dry (preferably locked) place inaccessible to children and pets. **Pesticide/Container Disposal: If empty:** Non-refillable container; do not reuse or refill this container. Offer for recycling if available. **If partially filled:** Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.

First Aid

Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes.
Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.
Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
Take off contaminated clothing.
Immediately rinse skin with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes.
