Do not apply over cuts, wounds or irritated skin. Do not apply near eyes and mouth. Apply sparingly around ears. Treatment may be applied on a bandage. **To Use as a Repellent:** Spread treatment lightly on outer and inner surface of the outer ear and between the toes before animals enter infested area. Do not repeat treatment for 3 to 5 days.

**Horses • Foals**

**To Control Ticks, Gnats, Flies, Mosquitoes and Mange Mites:** Before application remove dirt or debris by brushing or washing with a mild shampoo. Allow to completely dry. Apply a light film to affected areas daily, massaging into the skin for 2 to 3 days, then apply every 3 to 5 days as needed. Do not apply over cuts, wounds or irritated skin. Do not apply near eyes and mouth. Apply sparingly around ears.

**Storage and Disposal**

**Pesticide Storage:** Store in a cool, dry (preferably locked) place inaccessible to children and pets.
