The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the above referenced product in connection with the Pyrethrins, Piperonyl Butoxide, and MGK 264 REDs, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable.

NOTE: This product is not being reregistered under sections 3(c)5 and 4(g) of FIFRA at this time. Furthermore, any required mitigation language for pet spot-on products must be addressed in a separate amendment.

Please be aware that the record for this product currently contains the Confidential Statement of Formulation (CSF) listed below. Any previously dated CSFs are superseded.

- Basic CSF, dated October 28, 2011
- Alternate CSF A, dated October 28, 2011

A copy of your label stamped "Accepted" is enclosed along with copies of the acute toxicity and product chemistry reviews completed for the subject product. **To Use as a Repellent:** Spread treatment lightly on outer and inner surface of the outer ear and between the toes before animals enter infested area. Do not repeat treatment for 3 to 5 days.

**To Control Ticks, Gnats, Flies, Mosquitoes and Mange Mites:** Before application remove dirt or debris by brushing or washing with a mild shampoo. Allow to completely dry. Apply a light film to affected areas daily, massaging into the skin for 2 to 3 days, then apply every 3 to 5 days as needed. Do not apply over cuts, wounds or irritated skin. Do not apply near eyes and mouth. Apply sparingly around ears.

**Storage and Disposal**

**Pesticide Storage:** Store in a cool, dry (preferably locked) place inaccessible to children and pets.
