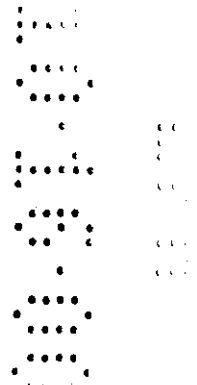

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Storage and Disposal

Storage: Store in a cool, dry (preferably locked) place inaccessible to children and pets. **Disposal:** Do not reuse empty container; wrap and put in trash.

Thoroughly soak animal with warm water taking 2-3 minutes to wet hair. Do not apply shampoo around eyes. Apply shampoo on head and ears, then lather; repeat procedure with neck, chest, middle and hind quarters, finishing legs last. Let animal stand 10 minutes (this is an important part of the grooming procedure), then thoroughly rinse animal. In extremely dirty or scaly animals the above procedure may be immediately repeated otherwise do not repeat treatment for one week. Do not use on puppies or kittens under 12 weeks. Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, medicated, aged, pregnant or nursing animals. Treat pet bedding and quarters simultaneously with a product approved for such use.
