Use Restrictions

R & M Rabbit and Deer Repellent Spray - RTU is a contact repellent containing 10% Thiram. It is a specially formulated ready-to-use (RTU), stable suspension that protects fruit and nut trees, fruit bushes and vines, ornamental trees and shrubs and nursery stock from the feeding damage caused by rabbits, deer and meadow mice. A single application will protect treated plant parts for as long as 3 months, depending on weather conditions.

Preapplication Directions

Keep from freezing. Shake well before using.

When to Apply: Apply only to dry plant surfaces under favorable conditions (moderate temperature and light winds) to ensure the white repellent film will form and set properly. Spraying under favorable conditions is also essential to avoid excessive runoff.

Application Methods

Spray Application: Using the attached sprayer, apply this product as a full coverage spray on trees (before planting), to ornamental plantings or to established nursery stock. Apply on fruit and nut trees, fruit bushes and viñes, ornamentals and nursery stock in late summer or early fall, or when rabbit, deer and/or rodent feeding damage is first noticed.

Brush Application: To protect plants' trunk from injury apply on lower trunk of fruit and nut trees and ornamental plantings from ground level to a height of approximately 21/2 feet.

Dip (Seedlings) Application: Dip foliage and other parts of ornamental trees and fruit and nut trees seedlings before planting. Thoroughly wet the foliage and other seedling parts to be protected. Allow excess repellent to run off dipped plants avoiding contact with the roots.

Post-application Directions

Immediately clean application equipment after using and before spray dries.

Labeling of Treated Seedlings

Label seedlings treated with this product with the following text:

CAUTION: Treated with Thiram. Handlers must wear the following personal protective equipment: long pants, long-sleeved shirt, shoes, socks and rubber gloves. Direct exposure to skin may result in severe dermatitis. Thoroughly dry seedlings and nursery planting stock before planting or storing.
