

Special Instructions for Improved Performance are:

- 1. Slugs and snails favor dark, damp places. Bait where these pests stay during daylight hours.
- 2. Be sure area to be baited is damp. In dry weather, water area well before baiting.
- 3. Apply bait in evening as these pests feed mainly at night.
- 4. In ornamental and border areas, until infestation is under control, bait should be renewed at least every 7 to 10 days or more frequently if necessary.
- 5. Since snails and slugs migrate extensively, when invasions from adjacent areas are anticipated a barrier of the bait will aid in control.
