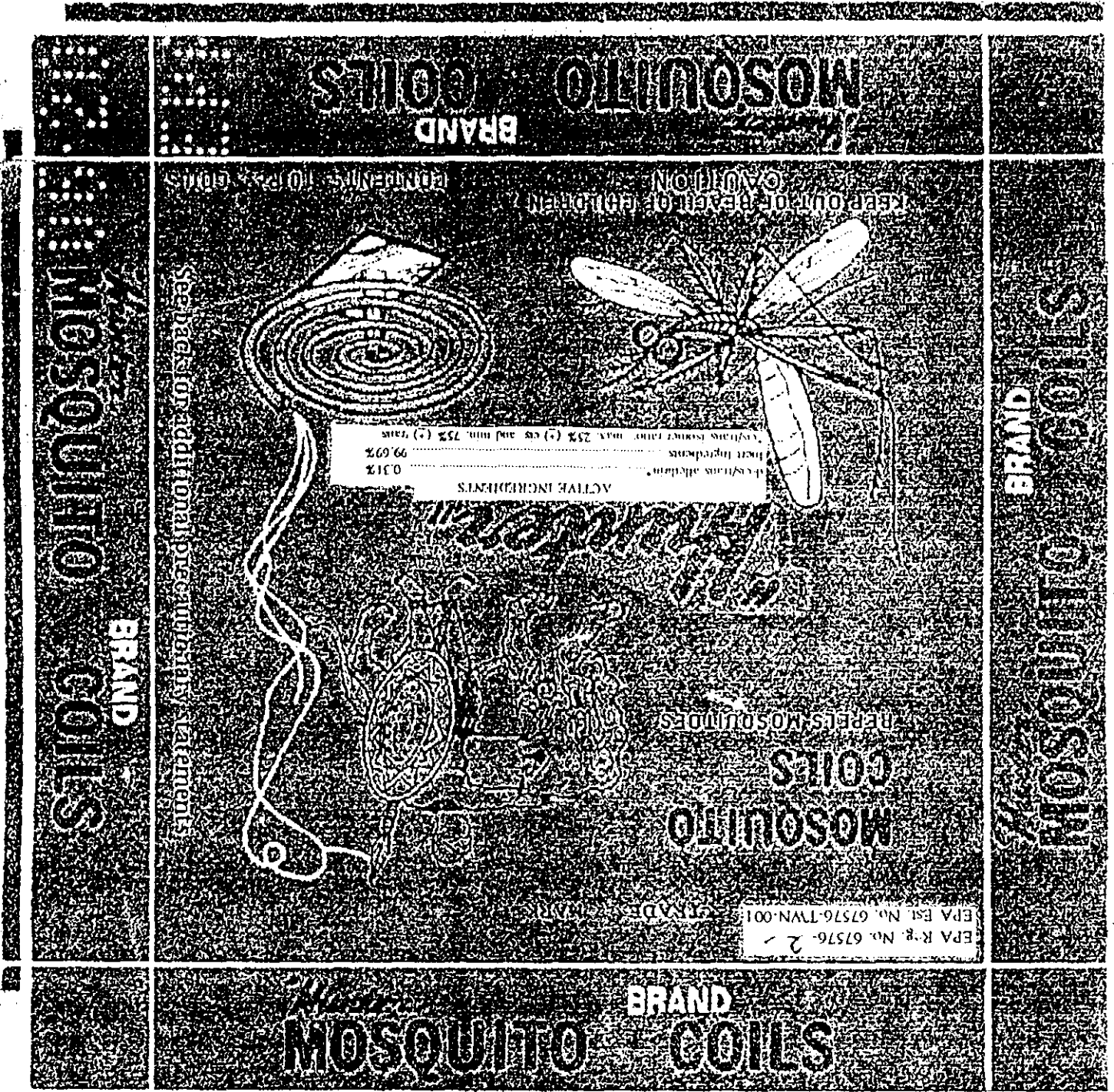

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELLING.

For best results, use outdoors in areas such as porches, patios, campsites and cabanas with little or no breeze. Place one coil every 6-10 feet.

Pull center piece of stand into upright position. Loosen outer rings of coils until ends move freely, and gently separate coils. Place tip of one coil in holding stand provided. Light outer end of coil until glowing. If shorter periods of use are desired, break coil into appropriate length.
