FIRST AID

USE FOR WHITE AND FAST COLORS ONLY IN THE LAUNDRY: Add 1/8 tup (1 oz.) of bleach per each 2 gallons of water to yield 200 ppm of available chlorine. • • • Boiling is unnecessary. Mix well. Wash in the usual way. As a bleach add 1/8 cup (1 • oz.) per 2 gallons of water or one cup of bleach per each washing machine load (16 • • • gallon machine). Rinse in several waters before drying. In automatics, bleach should be added to suds water before clothing is placed in machine. If added while clothing is in • • suds, dilute with 1 quart of water before adding.

#### DO NOT USE ON SILK, WOOL, OR ACETATE

STAIN REMOVER: To remove scorch, ink, fruit, tea, coffee, grass, or other stains, add ¼ cup of bleach to quart of water. Mix well and allow to soak until suds disappear. Rinse thoroughly.

TO CLEANSE OR DEODORIZE: All surfaces in bathroom and kitchen use 1 oz. Or 1/8 cup of bleach to quart of water. Cleanse surfaces with warm suds. Rinse. Follow with bleach solution. Soak 5 minutes. Rinse well.

SICK ROOM: To disinfect and deodorize: Use ½ cup (4 oz.) per each 2 gallons of water to yield 800 ppm of available chlorine. For rubber sheets, bedpans, etc. Immerse for 10 minutes and rinse.
