May cause staining (darkening) of asphalt surfaces and shingles. [Remove protective cap.] Hold can upright and point spray opening toward nest with wind at your back. Spray until nest is thoroughly saturated to kill the entire nest population. Residual action will keep wasps and hornets from returning to the nest. Wait at least 24 hours before removing the nest.

To Kill Bees, Hornets, Yellow Jackets and Wasps under eaves, screens, window frames, doors, patios, cracks, holes or crevices or wherever insects are noticed, spray for about 1-2 seconds where insects enter, such as outside plumbing, faucets, etc., and cracks or crevices in foundation as well as along sills and ledges.

Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store in a cool, dry area inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat, sparks and open flame.
