The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with comments:

Revised labeling per PR Notice 2001-1

GENERAL COMMENTS

- On the second page of the label under "Directions for Use", please insert "Do not use on 1. glasses, dishes or utensils" after the sentence "Not recommended for use on unpainted wood or glass".
- In the first paragraph on the third page of the label, delete "wipe enough" and insert "use 2. enough wipes".
- On the fourth page of the label, delete the site "floors". 3.
- Delete the following claims from the label which is on the third page: "Can help reduce 4. the risk of spreading (illness causing) bacteria from one surface to another", "of bacteria that can cause foodborne illness (opportunistic bacteria pathogens)", "can help stop the spread of organisms that cause the flu -and/or-", "common cold from one surface to another", "Quickly removes germs (and bacteria) from surfaces left by sneezing/coughing/touching (in one easy step)", "kills -or- effective againt (99.9%) of viruses", "can help reduce the risk of spreading illness causing bacteria from one surface to another", "can help reduce the risk of surface cross-contamination on treated surfaces during flu season", "Effective against opportunistic bacteria pathogens, "Effective against the virus that causes the common cold" "Effective against the virus that causes the

stomach flu", "After use, just toss wipes(s) and bacteria away".

- 5. In the sentence "Deodorizes by killing the germs that cause bad odors", delete the word germs and replace it with "bacteria".
- 6. Under the heading "To Disinfect and Deodorize", delete the words "wipe enough" and replace with "Use enough wipes".


