- b. On page 3 of 6, under the *Claims* section, in the bullet that states "Deodorizes by killing germs that cause odor", delete the word "germs" and insert the word "organism".
- c. On page 3 of 6, under the *Claims* section, in the bullet that states "Eliminates-or-Reduces odors [caused by germs or bacteria-and/or mildew]", delete the wording "germs or bacteria-and/or mildew" and insert in its place "odor causing organisms".
- d. On page 3 of 6, under the *Claims* section, in the bullet that states "Hospital grade disinfectant", delete the word "grade".
- e. On page 3 of 6, under the *Claims* section, in the bullet that states "Reduces the risk of infection and cross-contamination, delete the wording "the risk of infection and".
- f. On page 3 of 6, under the *Claims* section, in the bullet that states "[This product] controls the spread...", insert the word "treated" between the words "most" and "hard".
- g. On page 3 of 6, under the *Claims* section, in the bullet that states "This product meets AOAC...", insert the acronym "EPA" in front of the statement "standards for hospital disinfection".
- h. On page 3 of 6, under the *The Following is only for products with medical devices listed on the label* section, insert in this heading, after the word "*listed*" the wording "in tables 1 and 2".
- i. On page 4 of 6, under the *Table One Medical* section, under *Surfaces*, delete the bullet that states "patient chairs". Patient chairs can imply that it is used on porous surface chairs.
- j. On page 5 of 6, under the *Table Three Veterinary* section, under *Use Sites*, delete Equine Farms, Farms, Kennels, and Livestock-and/or-Swine-and/or-Poultry Facilities". In addition, under *Surfaces*, delete stalls and troughs. DISS/TSS-18 & 19 labeling requirements are necessary if you make claims for use on farm premises as disinfectants.
- k. On page 5 of 6, under the *Table Four Food Services* section, under *Surfaces*, in the first bullet that states "any washable (food and non-food...)" delete the word "food". In addition, under *Surfaces*, delete "food trays". In order to make food disinfectant claims for this product, the registrant needs to provide EPA clearance from the Food and Drug Administration.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
