

Hard Nonporous Surfaces: -or- Sealed Ceramic Tile, Porcelain, Shower Walls, Floors and Other Hard Nonporous Surfaces: [Set trigger to SPRAY.] Spray 6-8 inches from surface until surface is thoroughly wet. Allow this product to [penetrate and] remain wet for contact time listed below [-or- on label] [-or- on organism table]. Then wipe. [Rinse.] For heavily soiled areas, a precleaning is required. Rinse with potable water for food-contact surfaces. For all others, no rinsing is required. [If streaking is observed, wipe with a clean, damp [cloth -and/or- microfiber cloth -and/or- paper towel].

SOFT SURFACE[¥] **SANITIZATION**:

To Sanitize Soft Surfaces[¥] [(Fabrics[¥])]: Hold bottle upright -or- Spray 6" – 8" from surface. Spray until fabric is wet. DO NOT SATURATE. Let stand [for] 3 min[utes]. Allow to air dry.
