Your Submission of August 11, 1995

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA sec. 2(c)(7)(A), is acceptable provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration and reregistration under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.

2. The proposed supplemental label is acceptable and may be used in conjunction with the currently labeled product until the expiration date of the existing stocks provision of the Reregistration Eligibility Document (RED).

3. Make the following labeling changes before you release the product for shipment:

a. Add the signal word in English and Spanish below the child hazard warning. Assure that the signal word and child hazard warning are the appropriate type size.

b. Move the Spanish language statement at the bottom of the front panel to appear beneath the main signal word.

c. The signal word must also appear beneath the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals heading. At this location the signal word must be prominent but does not need to be in the type size for the main signal word.

d. Add a footnote to the ingredients statement indicating that the product "contains aromatic hydrocarbons".

4. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

Pipron Liquid Concentrate fungicide is highly effective against powdery mildew-causing fungi attacking rose, lilac, dahlia, phlox, zinnia, chrysanthemum, catalpa. Used as directed Pipron Liquid Concentrate will not harm foliage or floral tissue.

General Use Precautions

Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system.

Application Directions

Pipron Liquid Concentrate plus surfactant is to be mixed with water and applied as a spray to the foliage of ornamental plants. Sufficient pressure should be used in spraying Pipron Liquid Concentrate to ensure thorough coverage of all plant surfaces. Special care should be taken to thoroughly wet new terminal growth and plant areas already diseased with powdery mildew.

Mixing: Pour the recommended amount of Pipron Liquid Concentrate and surfactant into the spray tank during filling and mix thoroughly before spraying.

Rates and Spraying Schedule: To control powdery mildew, add to each 100 gallons of water 1/4 to 1/2 pint of Pipron Liquid Concentrate plus 2 to 4 ounces of one of the following surfactants:

Triton B-1956 (Not For Use in California)

No Foam B

Stepanol WA Paste (Not For Use in California)

Begin spraying soon after the first leaves expand or the first symptoms of powdery mildew appear. Use the higher rates if powdery mildew is already present. Apply every seven to ten days, or as needed.
