The supplemental label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable provided that the following revision is made:

1. Under the Storage and Disposal heading, the last sentence for Container Disposal must read as follow: "If drum is contaminated and cannot be reused, dispose of in the same manner **required for its liner.**"

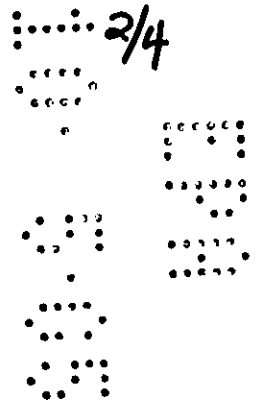
