GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

K-Pool 7 Algaecide provides effective control of algae growth in all types of swimming pools. Even though it affords long-term algae control, periodic additions on a scheduled basis will assure lasting algae control. Treated water may be used for swimming immediately after addition of K-Pool 7 Algaecide. K-Pool 7 Algaecide is designed to prevent the growth of swimming pool algae. For heavy algal infestations, more drastic treatment such as "shocking" or super-chlorination may be required to get the algae under control.

NOTE: Undiluted K-Pool 7 Algaecide or concentrations above 1.0 ppm Cu⁺⁺ may be injurious to crops, grass, ornamentals and other foliage. Do not apply in such a way that the concentrated product comes in contact with crops, ornamentals, grass, or desirable plants. Apply only as specified on the label. Do not allow back-flushed filter water to come in contact with desirable plant species.

Dilute K-Pool 7 Algaecide with at least nine parts of water and sprinkle around edge of pool. Acd additional amounts K-Pool 7 Algaecide every two weeks according to directions on the chart.

For newly filled pools, begin pool maintenance with K-Pool 7 Algaecide when the pool is first filled with water. Add K-Pool 7 Algaecide according to the size of pool as given in the chart.

How To Estimate Gallon Capacity of Your Pool:

Measure length (L), Width (W) and average Depth (D) in feet.

- For square or rectangular pools: L x W x D x 7.5 = Gallons.
- For circular or elliptical pools: L x W x D x 5.9 = Gallons.
