daylight remaining. To minimize this hazard, do not treat more than 1/3 to 1/2 of
the water body to avoid depletion of oxygen due to decaying algae. After the initial
treatment, do not treat the remainder of the water body for 2-3 days.

APPLICATION INFORMATION

Apply 3.0 to 100 pounds per acre-foot (equivalent to 0.3 to 10.2 ppm of hydrogen peroxide). Calculate rates based on the volume of water containing algae to be treated.

Note: Algae control is more easily achieved if treated soon after growth starts. Larger amounts of product may be needed to treat heavier blooms. As little as 2.5 pounds per acre - foot could be used for algaestatic treatment.

This product may be applied as a broadcast application, use of mechanical or manual spreader. To achieve optimal effectiveness, treat when algae growth first begins to appear and apply in a manner that will ensure even distribution of this product within the treatment area.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal.
