  - a. Change the product registration number to "EPA Reg. No. 67702-37"
  - b. Make the following label revisions:

General Comment:

- 1. Delete all text throughout the proposed label marked with "~~strike through~~."
- 2. Immediately following the product brand name at the top of page 1 of 3 of the subject label, revise the statement "For Manufacturing and Formulating Use" to read "An Insecticide for Manufacturing Use Only."

Precautionary Statements, Environmental Hazards subsection comment(s):

- 3. To facilitate inclusion of required label language from the RED for pyrethrins, within the 5<sup>th</sup> sentence of this subsection, replace the words "wash water" with the words "wash-waters."

HOT LINE NUMBER subsection comment(s):

- 4. To facilitate inclusion of required label language from the acute toxicity review completed for the proposed product, you must insert the following text statement, in a text box of its own for added prominence, immediately following the "Environmental Hazards" subsection that reads as follows:

- 3. You must submit two (2) copies of the revised final printed labeling, incorporating the above changes, before releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with section 6(e) of FIFRA. Your release for shipment of the product bearing amended labeling constitutes accepting of these conditions.

Should W. Neudorff GmbH KG wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, please be aware that the website becomes labeling under FIFRA and is subject to review by the Agency.
