

AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS

Chemigation: Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system.

Rainfastness: FLUTRIAFOL 250 g/L SC Fungicide is rainfast 2 hours after application. Disease control will be reduced if rainfall occurs within 2 hours of application.

Compatibility Jar Test: FLUTRIAFOL 250 g/L SC Fungicide is compatible with most products, however not all have been tested. Use the compatibility test to ensure physical compatibility.

Using a quart jar, add the proportionate amounts of the products to approximately one quarter of water with agitation. Add wettable powders and water dispersible granular products first, next liquid flowables, then emulsifiable concentrates, and last liquid soluble products. After thorough mixing, allow this mixture to stand for 5 minutes. If the combination remains mixed or can be readily remixed, it is physically compatible. Once compatibility has been proven, use the same procedure for adding products to the spray tank. When tank mixing, follow more restrictive labeling of any tank mix partner. Do not tank mix with any product that contains a prohibition on tank mixing.
