**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT:**

Immediately contact Poison Control Center or Physician if swallowed. If eye contact occurs, flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. Active Ingredient: Orthoboric Acid 100%.

**RECOMMEND APPLICATION ON ANNUAL BASIS TO CARPETED AREAS.**

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Children and pets should not be in treatment area until after application is completed. Avoid contamination of food and feedstuffs. Avoid contamination of ornamental plants. Apply to dry carpet only. Apply directly to carpets where pets frequently traffic at the rate of one pound per 100 square feet (26 mg/sq.in.). Work product to the base of the carpet pile with a broom or rug rake. Any powder visible after application must be brushed into carpet fibers or removed by vacuuming. Allow powder to remain 3 to 5 weeks for maximum flea control.

Repeat process after shampooing carpet. Reapply as necessary. For upholstery: remove loose cushions and apply to creases and into corners and furniture wells. Do not apply to exposed fabric. Any product visible after application must be removed.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:**

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

**STORAGE:** Keep container tightly closed when not in use. Store in original container, in a dry place inaccessible to children and pets.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** DO NOT reuse container. Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in landfill, or incinerator, or, if allowed by State and local authorities burn. If burned, stay out of smoke.
