The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as Amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below:

1. Revise the Precautionary Statements to read:  

"Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Causes eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling."
2. Revise the Statement of Practical Treatment to read:  

If Swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. If person is unconscious, do not give anything by mouth and do not induce vomiting.

If in Eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

If on Skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.

Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

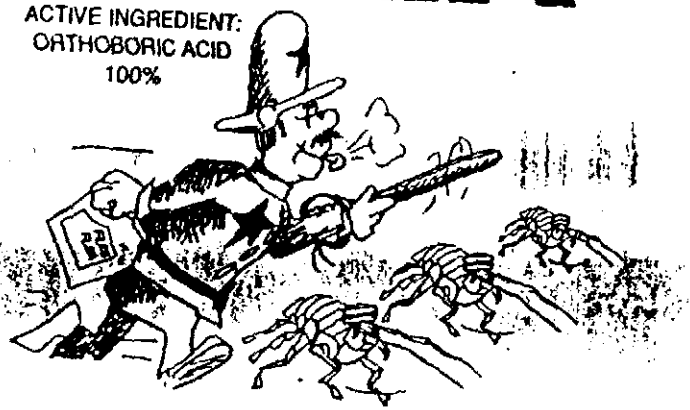

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT:

Immediately contact Poison Control Center or Physician if swallowed. If eye contact occurs, flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. Active Ingredients: Orthoboric Acid 100%.

RECOMMEND APPLICATION ON ANNUAL BASIS TO CARPETED AREAS.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Children and pets should not be in treatment area until after application is completed. Avoid contamination of food and feedstuffs. Avoid contamination of ornamental plants. In Homes or Apartments apply to dry carpets only. Apply directly to carpets where pets frequently traffic, at the rate of one pound per square feet (26 mg/sq.in.) Work product to the base of the carpet with a broom or rug rake. Any powder visible after application must be brushed into carpet fibers or removed by vacuuming. Allow powder to remain 3 to 5 weeks for maximum flea control.

Repeat process after shampooing carpet. Reapply as necessary. For upholstery: remove loose cushions and apply to creases and into corners and furniture wells. Do not apply to exposed fabric. Any product visible after application must be removed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Keep container tightly closed when not in use. Store in original container, in a dry place inaccessible to children and pets.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: DO NOT reuse container. Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in landfill, or incinerator, or, if allowed by State and local authorities burn. If burned, stay out of smoke.
