Reregistration under this section does not eliminate the need for continual reassessment of pesticides. EPA may require submission of data at any time to maintain the registration of your product.			
2. Make the following labeling changes before you release the product for shipment: a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 67869-17". b. Place the appropriate EPA Establishment No. on the product labeling.

- c. The word, poison, must appear in red on a background of distinctly contrasting color.
- d. Change the subheading, Statement of Practical Treatment to First Aid.
- e. Revise the First Aid statements to read as follows:

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes.

Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing.

Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF ON SKIN OF CLOTHING:

Take off contaminated clothing.

Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes.

Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice

Have a person sip a glass of water if able to swallow

Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by poison control center or doctor

Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reaction in some individuals. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

- h. Place the Storage and Disposal section directly below the misuse statement to read as follows:

Storage and Disposal

PROHIBITIONS: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal...empty containers.

PESTICIDE STORAGE:as minus 50 degrees Fahrenheit.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acute hazardous.....at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL:.....out of smoke.


3. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

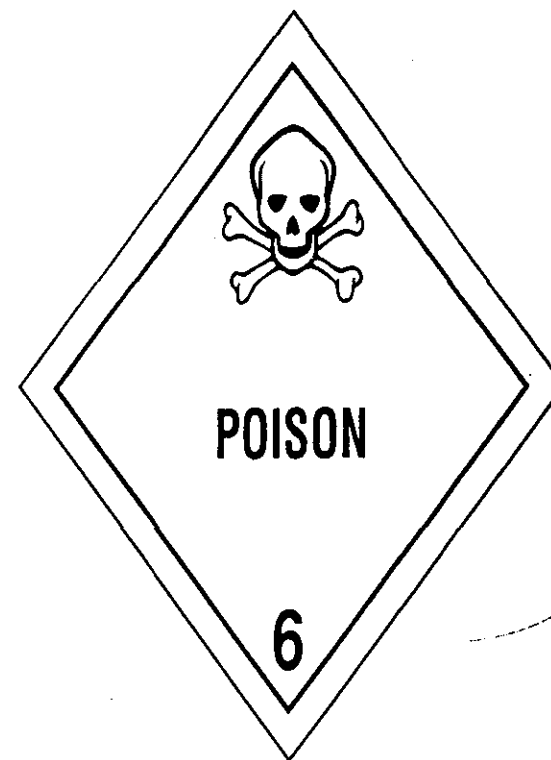
