

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This is a manufacturing use pesticide for repackaging and formulating as a microbiocidal algicide, bactericide and fungicide for use in recirculating water cooling towers, sewage disposal lagoons and as a preservative for paper and paperboard products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS:
Do not contaminate water, food or feed by

storage or disposal.
PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:

Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law.
