Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

FIRST AID

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor.

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measure against circulatory shock respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

This is a manufacturing use pesticide for repackaging and formulating as a microbiocidal algicide, bactericide and fungicide for use in recirculating water cooling towers, sewage disposal lagoons and as a preservative for paper and paperboard products. Formulators are responsible for obtaining pesticide registrations and preparing labeling in

compliance with EPA guidelines for formulations based on your products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:
Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.
