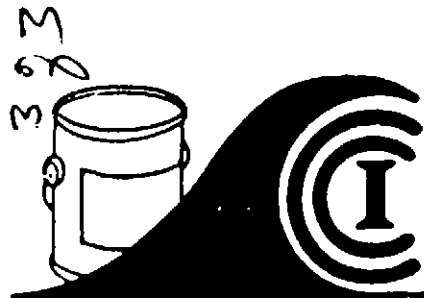

An anti-fouling protective coating for hulls, barnacles and other marine fouling.
