On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.

2. Make the following label changes before you release the product for shipment:

- a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 67959-1".
- b. Correct the spelling of the chemical name for the active ingredient in the Ingredient statement to read "...6-dinitro-N...".
- c. Delete the phrase "...if irritation persists" from the "IF IN EYES" statement.

d. Rewrite the Precautionary Statements to read as follows:

"Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly and change clothing after handling. The active ingredient trifluralin may cause skin sensitization reactions in certain individuals."

e. Rewrite the Environmental Hazards section to read as follows:

"Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance, contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA."

f. According to our records, trifluralin use on asparagus was never supported by the cited company, Industria Prodotti Chimici SpA. Therefore, this crop must be removed from list of acceptable uses for end-use products using this technical in their formulations.

g. The statement "Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility" occurs twice in the Storage and Disposal block. Since it is only required under the heading "Pesticide Disposal", the statement currently under the heading "Storage" may be deleted.

3. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record before you release this product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
