The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable with the following provisions:

- According to our records, the requirement of acute toxicity studies performed on this product was waived on the basis that this product was considered to be substantially similar to I.Pi.Ci. Industria Prodotti Chimici S.p.A.'s product Trifluralin Technical (EPA Registration No. 33660-3). Therefore, the precautionary labeling must be consistent with the language for that product. For this reason, the following revisions are necessary:
  - a) Add the statement "Get medical attention" to the end of the "If On Skin" statement in the Statement of Practical Treatment.
  - b) Revise the signal word appearing with the Precautionary Statements to read "CAUTION".
  - c) Revise the Precautionary Statements to read as follows:

"Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking or smoking tobacco products. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. The active ingredient trifluralin may cause skin sensitization reactions in certain individuals."
