quently traffic or sleep. Work powder deeply into fibers and mat with a broom or rug rake. Any Dowder visible after application must be brushed into carpet fibers or removed. For fleas, apply at the rate of 26 mg per square inch of carpet or 1 pound for every 1000 square feet of treated

UPHOLSTERY: Remove loose cushions. Apply along creases and into comers and furniture wells. Do not apply product to exposed fabric. Any product visible after application must be removed.
