DIRECTIONS FOR USE:
It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

USE RESTRICTIONS: Children and pets should not be in treatment area until after the application is completed. Do not treat pets with this product. Avoid contamination of food, food stuffs and ornamental plants.

CARPETS: Clean or vacuum the area before application. Apply to dry surfaces only. Apply directly to rugs & carpets where pets frequently traffic or sleep. Work powder deeply into fibers and mat with a broom or rug rake. Any powder visible after application must be brushed into carpet fibers or removed. For larval fleas, apply at the rate of 1 pound for every 1000 square feet of treated area.

PET RESTING & SLEEPING QUARTERS: FOR LARVAL FLEAS - Remove pet and sprinkle powder over flooring around and beneath pet sleeping quarters. Brush and work the powder into cracks and crevices for residual larval control. Remove any excess surface powder with a damp sponge or mop. Re-treat as needed.

UPHOLSTERY: Remove loose cushions. Apply along creases and into corners and furniture wells. Do not apply product to exposed fabric. Any product visible after application must be removed.

FOOD AREAS: For residential, commercial & industrial sites, application is limited to crack and crevice application only.
