2. Make the following change to the label:

- a. Change the product registration number to "EPA Reg. No. 68086-5"
- b. You must add IF IN EYES statement to read:

"IF IN EYES:

- Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes.
- Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.
- Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice."

- a. Remove "The BIG DADDY of Boric Acid Roach Killers" from the label.
- b. Remove "Wipe Out Roaches" from the label.
- c. The image presented on the label is false and misleading, as the syringe does not kill the cockroach. This image must be removed.
- d. Remove the following marketing claims:
 - "Kills roaches continuously."
 - "Kills'em really dead."
 - "Safe and effective when used as directed."
 - "Approved" from "Approved for use in commercial, industrial, institutional and home use; Food prep area."
 - "Now you see'em- soon you won't"
 - "Applicator for long term control."
- e. Revise the Net Weight to "1 ounce/28.35 gms."
- f. Within the Directions for Use, insert the following statement: **FOR INDOOR USE ONLY**" and add the following restriction: **"APPLY THIS PRODUCT ONLY IN AREAS THAT ARE INACCESSIBLE TO CHILDREN AND PETS."**
- g. Modify the following sentence¹: "Apply ~~freely and hide~~ Roach Enderzz gel bait *in small amounts to inaccessible areas* behind and under areas such as: Stoves, refrigerators..... and closets.
- h. Remove drawers from chests and cabinets; "Apply ~~freely and hide~~ bait *in in small amounts to inaccessible areas* of corners of drawer wells."
- i. Revise the following sentence as follows: "~~Avoid contamination of feed and food stuffs.~~", to **"DO NOT CONTAMINATE FOOD OR FEED."**
- j. Remove the Warranty and Disclaimer statement. You may refer to the following Agency internet site for Warranty and Disclaimer statements that are currently being accepted by the Agency:

Kills Roaches in RESIDENTIAL, COMMERCIAL, INDUSTRIAL and INSTITUTIONAL sites, such as Homes, Hospitals, Restaurants, Condominiums, Apartments, Grocery Stores, Institutional & Commercial Buildings, Schools, Cafeterias, bottling plants, Warehouses, Storage Areas, Food Processing Plants, Mobile Homes, Boats, Military Bases, Theaters, Camps, Nursing Homes or Military, Commercial, and Cruise Ships.

Kills Roaches

For Domestic, Residential, Industrial, Commercial and Institutional use: Apply freely and hide Roach Enderzzz gel bait behind and under areas such as: Stoves, refrigerators, dish washers, sinks, washing machines, tubs, water pipes, drains, sewers, man holes, cracks and crevices in baseboards, in corners of cupboards, cabinets and closets. Remove drawers from chests and cabinets, and apply freely and hide bait in corners of drawer wells. Apply every two or three months if required. All visible gel should be packed into cracks and crevices. Remove excess gel and dispose into garbage. Do not apply in traffic paths or areas accessible to children and pets. Avoid contamination of feed and food mills.

Kills Roaches:

In food and feed establishments, Application is limited to crack and crevice treatment by hiding the gel bait only in areas where food and feed stuff are received, stored, prepared, packaged, (canning-boxing or wrapping), or served. Care must be taken to avoid depositing the product on serving surfaces where food and feed stuff are processed. Place the Gel only in cracks and crevices in food handling establishments.

Serving Areas: In Dining Rooms, apply into cracks or crevices such as baseboards and floor cracks. Avoid areas likely to be contacted by food.

Non-Food Areas: Apply to cracks, and crevices by hiding the gel bait around water pipes in areas such as: garbage rooms, locker rooms, mop closets, boiler rooms, and lavatories.

IMPORTANT: For continued roach control make sure to replace bait that has been consumed. Roaches are attracted to and will consume the bait until they die.
