On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. 2. Make the following label changes:
  - a) Add the statement: Use Restrictions: "Do not use in food/feed area of food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared food are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where food may be prepared or held". Place this statement at the end of the paragraph under the section in the Use Directions ".....until application is completed.
  - b) You must add an IF IN EYES statement in the First Aid Statement to read as follows:
 

IF IN EYES: o Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes  
o Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 15 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.  
o Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

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- c) An acceptable one year Storage Stability (830.6317) and Corrosion Characteristic (830.6320) study must be provided within one year of the accepted date of registration.
- d) Revise the EPA Registration No. to read "EPA Reg No. 68086-6".
- 4. Submit four (4) copies of the revised final printed labeling for the record.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

**DIRECT IN USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Children and pets should not be in the treatment area until application is completed.

Do not contaminate feed or food stuffs. Do not apply in serving areas while food is exposed. Place bait only out of traffic ways, and in areas that are inaccessible to children and pets. Ants are attracted to and will feed on **Ant Enderzzz** until they die.

The ants return to their nests after consuming the bait and feed their young and the queen. When all of the members of the colony have consumed the bait, the entire colony will die.

**Ant Enderzzz** may be placed around and under areas where ants are trailing or have been seen crawling, including food cabinets, sinks, stoves, refrigerators, food storage areas, window sills and frames (as well as exterior window sills and doorways to help prevent entry of ants), openings around pipes, baseboards, attics, garages, basements, storage areas, closets, and other similar areas.

**FOR USE WITH BAIT CONTAINERS AND BAIT STATIONS:**

Wash hands thoroughly before handling bait containers and bait stations to remove any odors that may repel ants (i.e. tobacco, garlic, strong chemicals or cleaners, etc.). Fill bait containers with 0.25 oz. of **Ant Enderzzz** and place on the floor or on a flat surface in areas where ants are trailing or have been seen crawling.

**FOR DIRECT PLACEMENT:** Make small, pea-sized placements and / or thin lines of **Ant Enderzzz** in areas where ants may crawl. Long thin lines allow many ants to feed on the bait. Repeat placement of the bait as necessary until satisfactory results have been obtained.

Do not use sprays, foggers or any strong chemicals or cleaners near the bait containers or placements. This may contaminate the bait and cause ants to cease feeding.

**IMPORTANT:** For continued ant control make sure to replace bait that has been consumed. Ants are attracted to and will consume the bait and take it back to feed the Colony and the Queen until the entire colony dies!
