On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

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- The stamped approved label may not be reprinted. reprinting of the label is necessary, the following changes are required. Each packet must contain the signal word "Caution" and the phrase "KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN", product name, ingredient statement, registration number, and a referral statement to see outer package for detailed instructions and precautions. Delete the ingredient "Lemongrass" on the packets to make your ingredient statement agree with the outer packaging. On the outer package do not print separate "directions" and "directions for use"; combine all instruction for use under the "directions for use" heading after the sentence, "It is a violation of federal law to use.... " In the directions include the sentence, "Repeat every hour or as necessary for desired protection." If a new label is printed, submit five complete final printed labels for our files. Your product labeling must comply with the Labeling Requirements for Pesticides and Devices, 40 CFR Part 156.10.
- 4. For subsequent printing of your labels, the EPA Registration Number shall read, "EPA Reg. No. 68125-3".

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your subsequent release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
